CELEBRATION GIVING

It is appropriate that a group that started out in 1916 calling itself The Ladies Aid Society would continue the tradition of benevolence. The Guild's giving falls into several categories. "Budgeted Giving" consists of a pledge to the general mission of National Presbyterian Women, Presbyterian Women of the Western Reserve and Church Women United. After meeting these commitments and our operating expenses, any monies remaining from member pledges and fundraising activities are designated for the "extra" or "year end" giving. A special collection in the spring, the Birthday/Thank Offering, raises money for National Presbyterian Women mission projects.

Gifts are directed to many Presbyterian projects, local charities and Fairmount Presbyterian Church efforts.

Our Dedicated Fund, established in 1987 as a result of a generous gift, has provided additional funds to support benevolence requests. Recommendations for distribution are made by the Committee and approved by the Guild Coordinating Team. Dedicated Fund also underwrites transportation and health aides to allow members from nursing homes to attend special Guild programs. We are grateful for these and other gifts which provide continuing resources for special needs.

At Fairmount Church the Guild's support of benevolences has been facilitated by special projects such as the Spring Rummage Sale.

MEMBERSHIP IN FAIRMOUNT GUILD

Presbyterian Women of Fairmount Presbyterian Church for tradition and simplicity have chosen to continue to be known as the “Fairmount Guild.” Any woman who supports the purposes of Presbyterian Women is encouraged to participate. Membership in Fairmount Presbyterian Church is *not* a prerequisite. The Guild offers a unique setting for women of all ages to give support to one another and address the concerns of not only Cleveland, but the world community. Guild presents opportunities for each woman to express and expand her Christian faith through study, affirmation of belief, and a shared effort in ministry.

Guild women determine their own leadership, program and budget while connecting their time, talents and funds to church-wide Presbyterian Women. Members support the mission of the church not only locally, but nationally and internationally.

Two times during the year Home Circles will be held at members’ homes. Check the program schedule for dates and times. Any woman who has not been listed with a particular circle may contact the Moderator or any Circle Leader to be placed on a Circle’s Active or Associate roster. Home and church Circle meetings offer an especially important time for smaller gatherings to provide a caring, inclusive community.

A HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

A nucleus of those who would become the women of Fairmount Presbyterian Church gathered together several years prior to the ratification of the Charter (October 23, 1916). They had two goals: to provide Christian education for their children and to bring together the families in the newly-developed neighborhood.

In 1915 a Sunday School was established. It met every Sunday in the real estate office owned by the Shaker Heights Land Development Co. Adult services were held Sunday evenings in the homes of various people. When the Presbyterian Union purchased two lots on the corner of Scarborough Road and Fairmount Boulevard, the women raised \$600 towards the building of a church on the property.

Prior to October 23, 1916, this group of 50 to 60 women was referred to as the Women's Aid Society. After the acceptance of the Charter, they changed their name to the Women's Sewing Society of Fairmount Presbyterian Church. In June of 1917, they became the Women's Society of Fairmount Presbyterian Church. Meetings were held on Tuesdays in the homes of members or at the church.

In March of 1931, a group of Fairmount women formed the Guild, which functioned independently of the Women's Society. Then in June, 1935, the Guild joined forces with the Women's Society for a total membership of 280 women. During 1937, the group changed its name to Fairmount Guild.

Following the union of the Northern and Southern Presbyterian Churches, the national Women's Associations adopted the name "Presbyterian Women of the Presbyterian Church (USA)." In the spirit of this change, in July of 1988, Fairmount Guild became a part of the Presbyterian Women of the Presbyterian Church (USA), but continues to refer to itself informally as the Fairmount Guild.
